## Player & Parent Expectations

Players are expected to commit to attend practice on a regular basis and help to contribute to the overall team development. All team practices are mandatory for each player. There are no guarantees of playing time because of the competitive nature of sports; however, every player will get playing time in every game. How much playing time a player receives is dependent upon those players' commitment to practice and ability to execute what is being taught. All starting positions are earned during practice. If a player habitually misses practice, they can expect not to start or have much playing time.

As a parent, you want the best for your child(ren). Our coaches also want the best for your child(ren). In order for this to occur, it is important that parents, no matter how knowledgeable you might be, please refrain from coaching your child during practices and games. The coach has all the players' interests in mind. It is always uncomfortable for a coach to remove a player from a practice or game because they are acting upon their parent's coaching rather than fulfilling the expectations of the team and coach. A parent needs to be positive at all times and cheer for every member of the team. Any questions concerning the coaching should be brought to the coach's attention in a private conversation without child(ren) present.
